

# LECCO: 5 THINGS TO SEE IF YOU DON'T HAVE MUCH TIME

*Close one to each other and reachable from the train station*



**THE WALLS**

The walls wanted by Azzone Visconti were built to protect the fortified town. The walls near the train station are the only ones still visible nowadays.



**CHURCH AND BELL TOWER**

The Basilica, dedicated to San Nicolò, was built on the remains of the walls of the ancient town. The bell tower is 96 metres high, one of the highest in Italy. Upon reservation, you can visit it.



**THE SQUARES**

Piazza Cermenati and Piazza XX settembre are the heart of the city, surrounded by residential buildings. You can visit the Palazzo delle Paure and walk until Piazza Manzoni to see the statue of the famous writer.



**THE TOWER**

This only remain of the fortifications is a quadrangular tower of the XIV century. It is in a corner of piazza XX settembre. On the first floor you can see some temporary exhibitions.



**THE LAKESIDE**

You can walk along the lakeside so as not to miss the golden statue of San Nicolò in the lake, the floating platform and the war monument. Relax for some minutes on a bench to enjoy the landscape
